This year there are 60 finalists across 15 awards vying for the chance to win on the 19th of July at the The Museum of Contemporary Art, Sydney. ABC Journalist Chris Bath will act as Master of Ceremonies on the night, overseeing awards including the best Small, Medium, Large business; Service Excellence; Retail Presentation; and the overall gold winners of the Flower and Produce Growers of the Year, Greengrocer and Florist of the Year.
